Here are some ideas for using the Mini Cube Puzzle Box Set: (you will need more than one for most of those ideas. If interested you can buy more here: Mini Cube Puzzle Box Set - Pack of 24 Balance IQ Party Favor Games for Kids, Teens and Adults, 1.5 Inch 3D Brain Teaser Maze Ball Toy Puzzles by Bedwina)

- Challenge Races: Set up a timed challenge where kids race to see who can solve their cube puzzle the fastest. You can have multiple rounds with different difficulty levels to keep it interesting.
- 2. **Puzzle Relay:** Divide kids into teams and set up a relay race where each team member has to solve one side of the cube puzzle before passing it to the next player. The first team to solve all sides wins!
- 3. **Memory Game:** Mix up the cube puzzles and lay them face down. Players take turns flipping two puzzles over at a time, trying to find matching pairs.
- 4. **Cube Tower Building:** Challenge kids to stack the cube puzzles on top of each other to build the tallest tower possible. The catch is that they have to solve each puzzle before adding it to the tower!
- 5. **Puzzle Scavenger Hunt:** Hide the cube puzzles around the play area or indoors. Kids have to find all the puzzles and solve them to complete the scavenger hunt.
- 6. **Pattern Replication:** Create a pattern using the cube puzzle and have kids replicate it using their own puzzles. Increase the difficulty by adding more complex patterns.
- 7. **Cube Puzzle Art:** Provide markers or stickers and let kids decorate their cube puzzles. They can create their own designs or use stencils to make patterns.
- 8. **Puzzle Charades:** Write down different actions or animals on slips of paper. Kids have to solve a puzzle before acting out the word on their slip of paper for others to guess.
- 9. **Team Puzzle Challenges:** Set up team challenges where kids have to work together to solve larger cube puzzles. This encourages teamwork and cooperation.
- 10. **Cube Puzzle Races**: Line up the cube puzzles in a row and have kids race to see who can solve all of them in the shortest amount of time. It's a fun way to test their puzzle-solving skills!
