- 1. **Matching Game:** Turn over cards and find pairs with the same pictures.
- 2. Number Learning: Look at cards with numbers and learn what they look like.
- 3. **Counting Fun:** Count how many things are on the cards or how many cards you have.
- 4. **Sorting Cards:** Sort cards by color, number, or picture.
- 5. **Math Games**: Play adding or subtracting games with the numbers on the cards.
- 6. **Memory Game:** Try to remember where the matching cards are when you turn them over.
- 7. **Making Patterns:** Put cards in order from smallest to biggest numbers or make patterns with colors.
- 8. **Story Time:** Make up stories about the pictures on the cards.
- 9. **Playing Together:** Play card games with friends or family to practice sharing and taking turns.

Card Game ideas:

- 1. **Go Fish:** Ask others for cards you need to make sets of four. If they don't have the card, you draw from the deck.
- 2. War: Compare cards with others, and the one with the highest card wins both.
- 3. Crazy Eights: Match cards with the top one in the pile, or draw until you can.
- 4. Snap: Shout "Snap!" when you see two matching cards in a row. Win the pile.
- 5. **Go Boom:** Match cards with the top one in the pile, or draw until you can. First to get rid of all cards wins.
- 6. **Spit:** Race to play your cards onto the center piles. Match cards in order.
- 7. **Old Maid:** Get rid of pairs. The one left with the "Old Maid" card loses.
