Here are some simple ideas for children to play Tic Tac Toe:

- 1. **Classic Tic Tac Toe:** Draw a grid of 3x3 squares on paper and take turns with a friend drawing Xs and Os to try and get three in a row horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.
- 2. **Outdoor Tic Tac Toe:** Use chalk to draw a Tic Tac Toe grid on pavement or a sidewalk. Then, use rocks or sticks as Xs and Os to play the game.

- 5. **Memory Tic Tac Toe:** Lay out a grid of cards facedown, each with a different picture or symbol. Players take turns flipping over two cards at a time, trying to find matching pairs. If they find a matching pair, they get to place their X or O on the Tic Tac Toe grid.
- 6. **Tic Tac Toe Math:** Instead of Xs and Os, use numbers 1-9 to fill the grid. Players take turns placing numbers, and the goal is to get three numbers that add up to 15 in a row, column, or diagonal.
- 7. **Tic Tac Toe Art:** Draw a Tic Tac Toe grid on paper, and each player takes turns drawing their own designs (like hearts, stars, or smiley faces) instead of Xs and Os.
- 8. **Tic Tac Toe Story:** Draw a Tic Tac Toe grid and write a word or draw a picture in each square. Players take turns making up a story, using the words or pictures they land on in the grid.
- 9. Tic Tac Toe Scavenger Hunt: Hide objects around the house or yard, and draw a Tic Tac Toe grid on a piece of paper. Each player takes turns finding objects and placing them on the grid until someone gets three in a row.
- 10. **Tic Tac Toe Relay Race:** Set up multiple Tic Tac Toe grids, and divide into teams. Players take turns racing to place their X or O on the grid. The first team to get three in a row on all their grids wins!

These ideas make playing Tic Tac Toe even more exciting and engaging for kids!
